

Waste



How to use your container:

1. Bag and place all regular and non-recyclable household garbage inside the cart.
2. Wheel out your cart with its lid closed. You must be able to close the lid without packing garbage in the cart too tightly; otherwise, the excess weight will make emptying of the cart more difficult.
3. Place the cart roadside by 7:00 AM on collection day wheels facing towards the curb. Material beside or on top of the cart will not be picked up.
4. Return empty cart from the street and on to your property before the end of the day.
5. Carts are assigned to each civic address by serial number. Do not remove the cart from its assigned address.
6. Inform the municipal office or Greenland Waste Disposal of any damage, vandalism or theft of the cart. It is important to note the serial number stamped on the cart placed at your residence by recording it in this brochure.

Items not allowed in the waste cart

- Sod, dirt or concrete
- Ashes of any description
- Construction or demolition materials including boards, roofing materials, carpets, etc.
- Automotive parts, oil filters, oil, etc.
- Tree clippings greater than 6" in diameter and 18" in length or yard waste
- Liquids of any kind
- Tires
- Animals or animal parts
- Fuel, adhesives or combustibles
- Batteries, Freon or hazardous waste
- Recycle material

All yard waste, such as grass clippings and tree limbs, can be taken into the compost site at no charge. The only exception is Elm trees, which must be disposed of at the landfill and buried.

Place these items all loosely into your cart

Single stream recycling simply means that all of your recyclables can be placed into one cart.

No need to sort anymore.

Place all recyclables loose into your blue cart.

Paper and cardboard

- Newspaper, catalogues, paper, cardboard, telephone books, soup and beverage containers and shredded paper (in a clear plastic bag)

Metal

- Clean metal food cans
- Clean metal lids from bottles, cans and jars
- Aluminum foil and containers (all rinsed)

Plastic

- Plastics must have the recycle symbol 1-7
- Deposit beverage containers can also be returned to Sarcen



Recycle



Reduce your facility's waste disposal costs by recycling your non-hazardous waste. By recycling, more than 2.5 millions tons of newspapers a year, about 41 million trees are saved worldwide. And by recycling more than 1.5 millions tons of cardboard, we recycle more than 6 billion boxes each year. Material such as plastic bottles and aluminum cans are easily recovered through Greenland Waste's commercial programs.

- Clean off food scraps and other residue
- It is okay to leave food labels on metal food cans, plastic containers, etc.
- Remove plastic wrapping from magazines and catalogues
- Shredded paper should be put in a clear plastic bag
